To: All HKU students,

Enrich your global exposure through the CEDARS Global Career Springboard Scheme (CGCSS) today! International Internships, Career Exploration Programmes, and other career learning experiences in all around the world await you within the CGCSS!

It is the time of the year for our annual **Japan Career Exploration Programme!** CEDARS – Career & Placement, will again collaborate with LOAITA Corporation (Japan) and Circle Vision Training and Development Centre (HK), to bring HKU students to Japan virtually! Since its transition to virtual last year, the Programme, which already received many positive feedbacks from students, has been finely tuned based on last year experience to become even better. Lasting from **6 to 14 January 2022**, the programme will give everyone interested a chance to break through the physical barrier to gain a broader career outlook and to prepare for a prospect in Japan!

Contrary to common belief, there has been no Japanese language requirement for this programme since its first launch! Students who would like to explore the Japan career market, working culture, Japanese companies and exchange views with company representatives are more than welcome to join!

The career exploration programme is designed to connect both non-local and local students, corporates from Japan and alumni working in Japan. It is not only educational but also career-driven, aims at:

- Boosting students' knowledge in selected industries, corporate cultures and exploring career opportunities;
- Providing students with knowledge in the job market, hunting process and, interview techniques;
- Raising the appreciation and strengthening integration among local and nonlocal students

For the same purpose of connecting different cultures and widening students' exposure, university students from other local and overseas universities may participate in this programme as well, and will be confirmed later.

Programme Highlights

Corporate Presentation and Staff Sharing

Around 8-10 sizable and well-known Japanese companies will give students a rare insider glimpse on their working culture, operation mechanisms and corporate values. Examples of companies* on our list that you may have already heard of:
